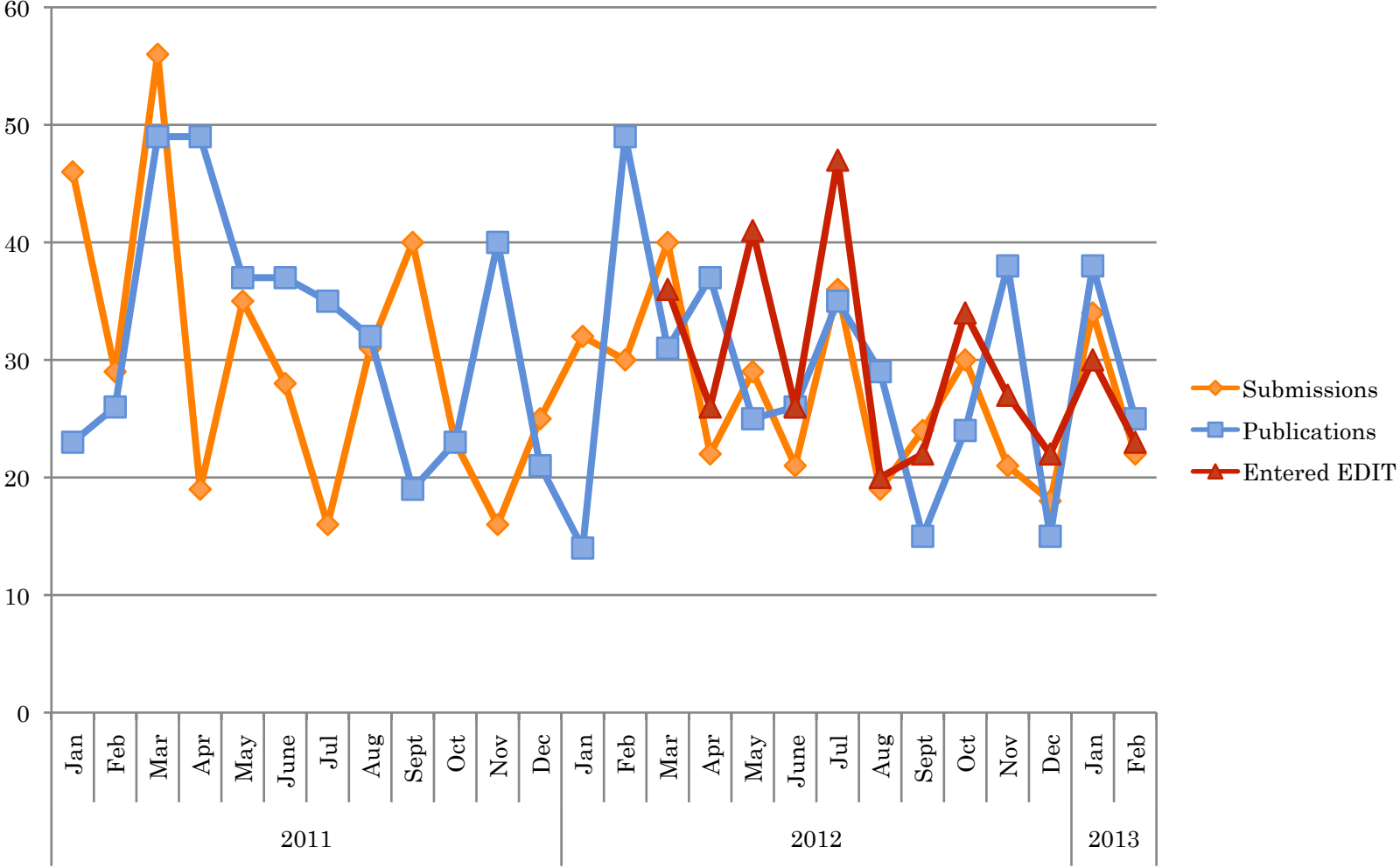

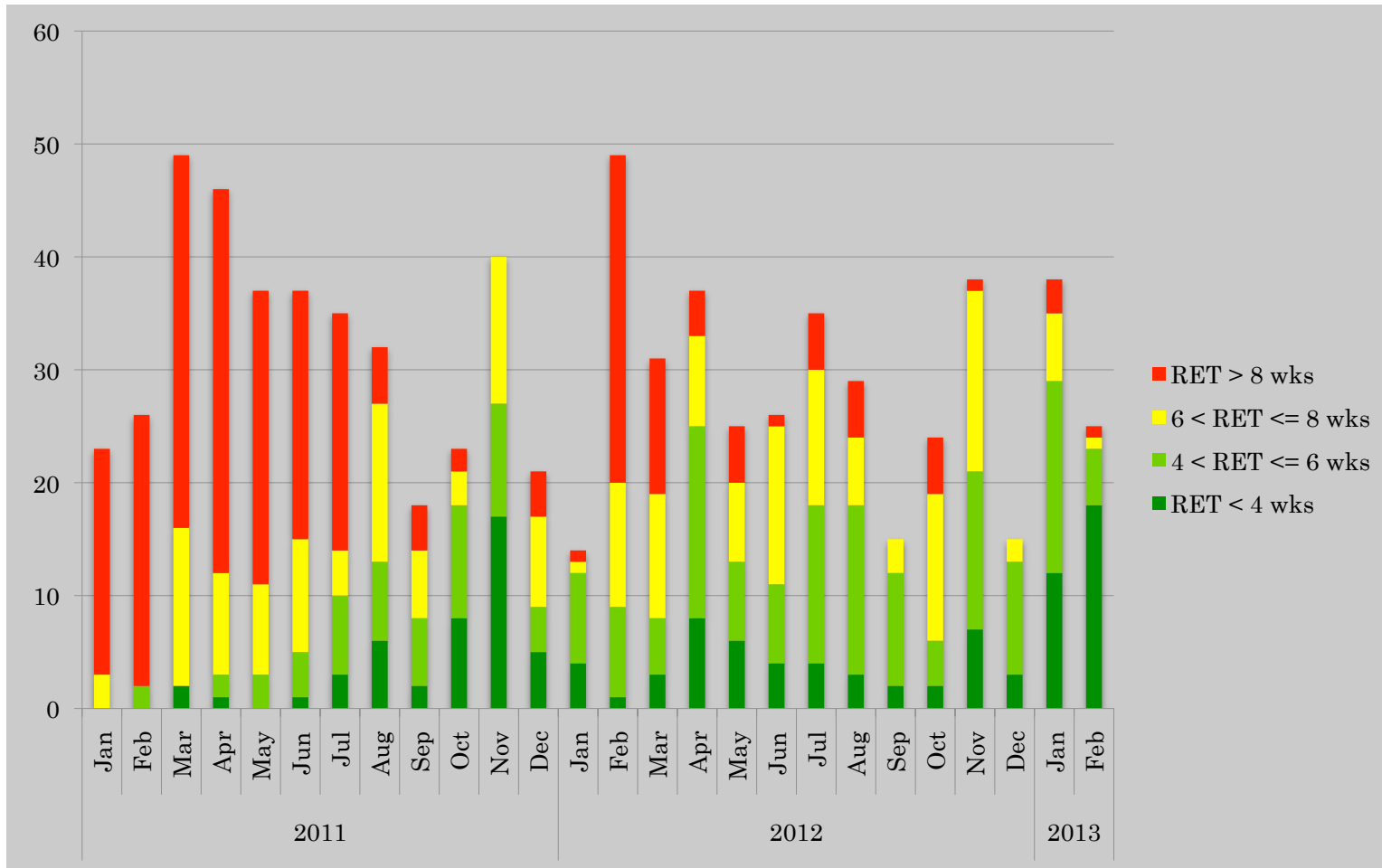

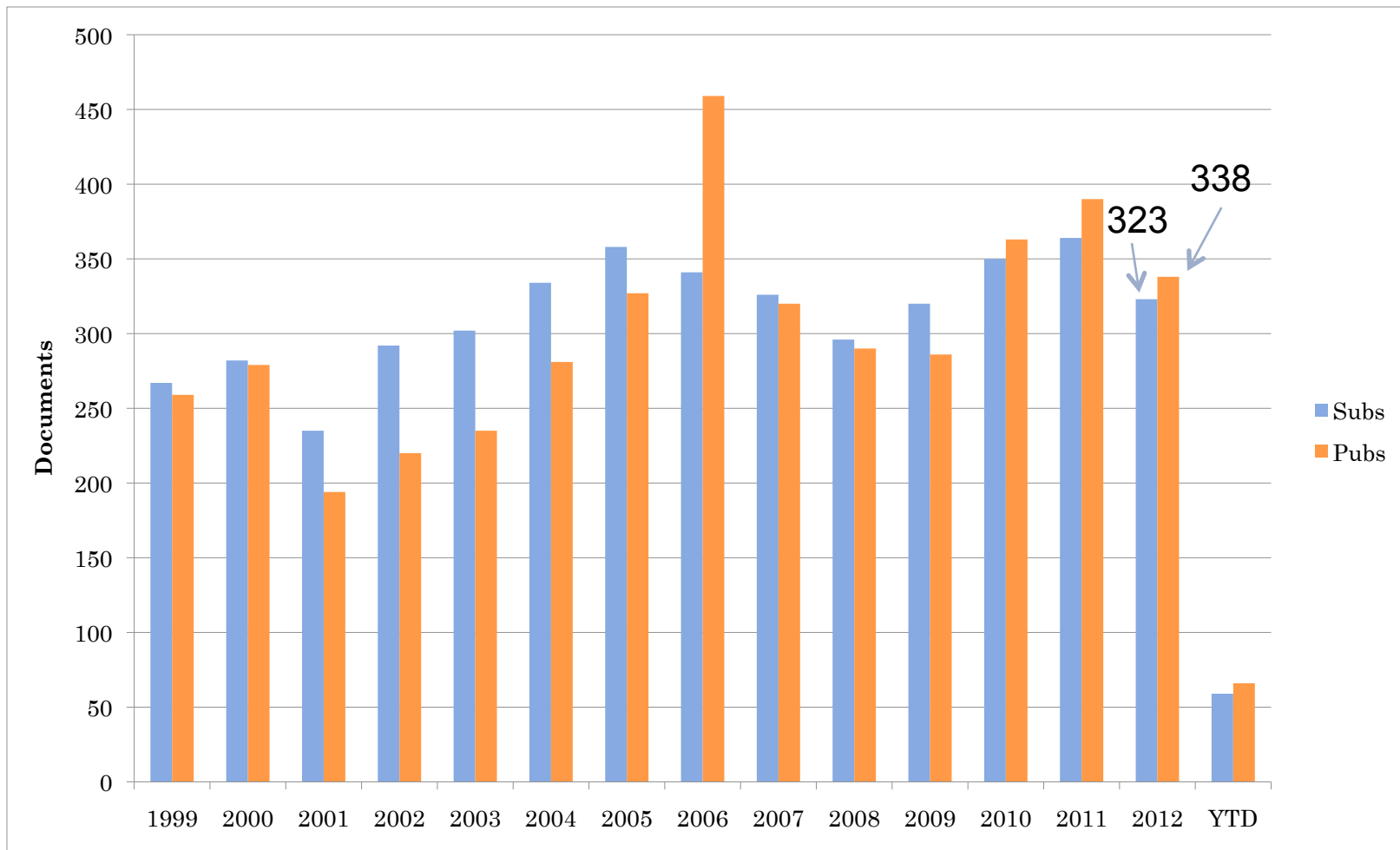

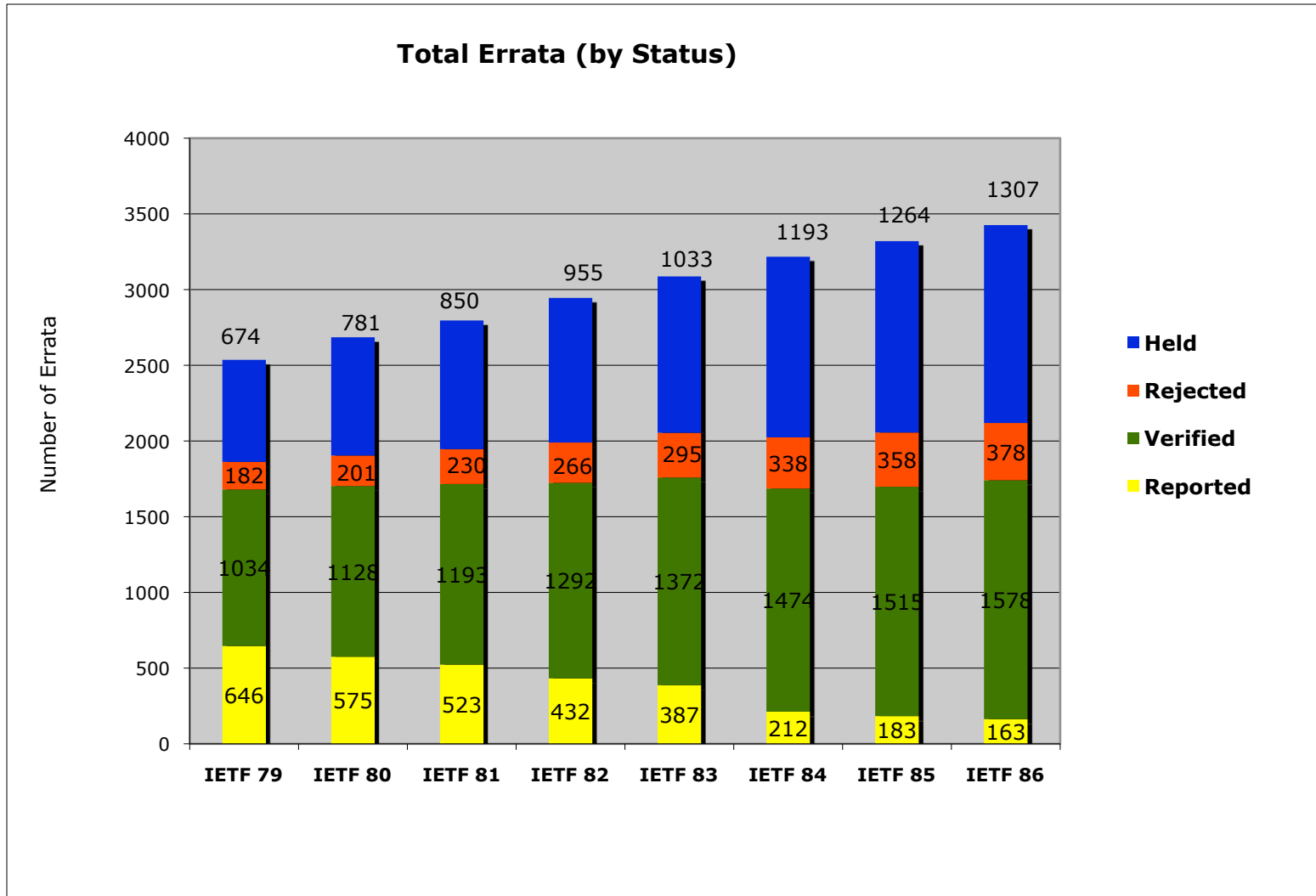

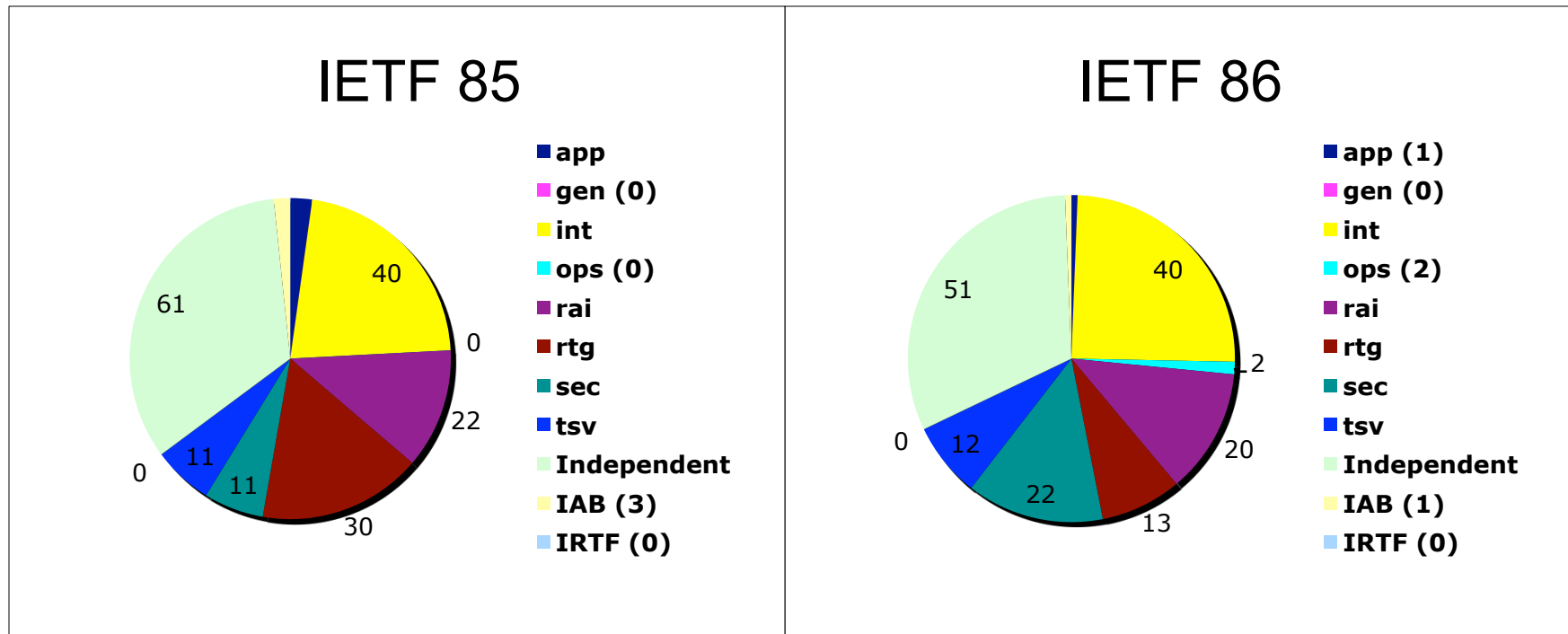

1. RFC Editor → Datatracker (complete)
2. Datatracker → RFC Editor (for IETF 87)

- Beta testing XML2RFC v2

Posting to issue tracker

RFC FORMAT

- draft-iab-rfcformatreq-03 posted
 - Captures the Requirements, not the Decision
 - Official IAB Last Call period = 12 – 27 December 2012
 - IETF-wide comment period = 1 February – 1 March 2013
- Decision Review Path
RSOC → Stream Managers → IESG, IAB, IRSG, ISE → Community
- Decision Announcement - between IETF 86 and 87
- Tools Development (significant)
Development of an appropriate SoW and work plan
- Implementation details may necessitate adjustment to requirements to be practicable

Note: Revising the Style Guide becomes critical in determining implementation details
